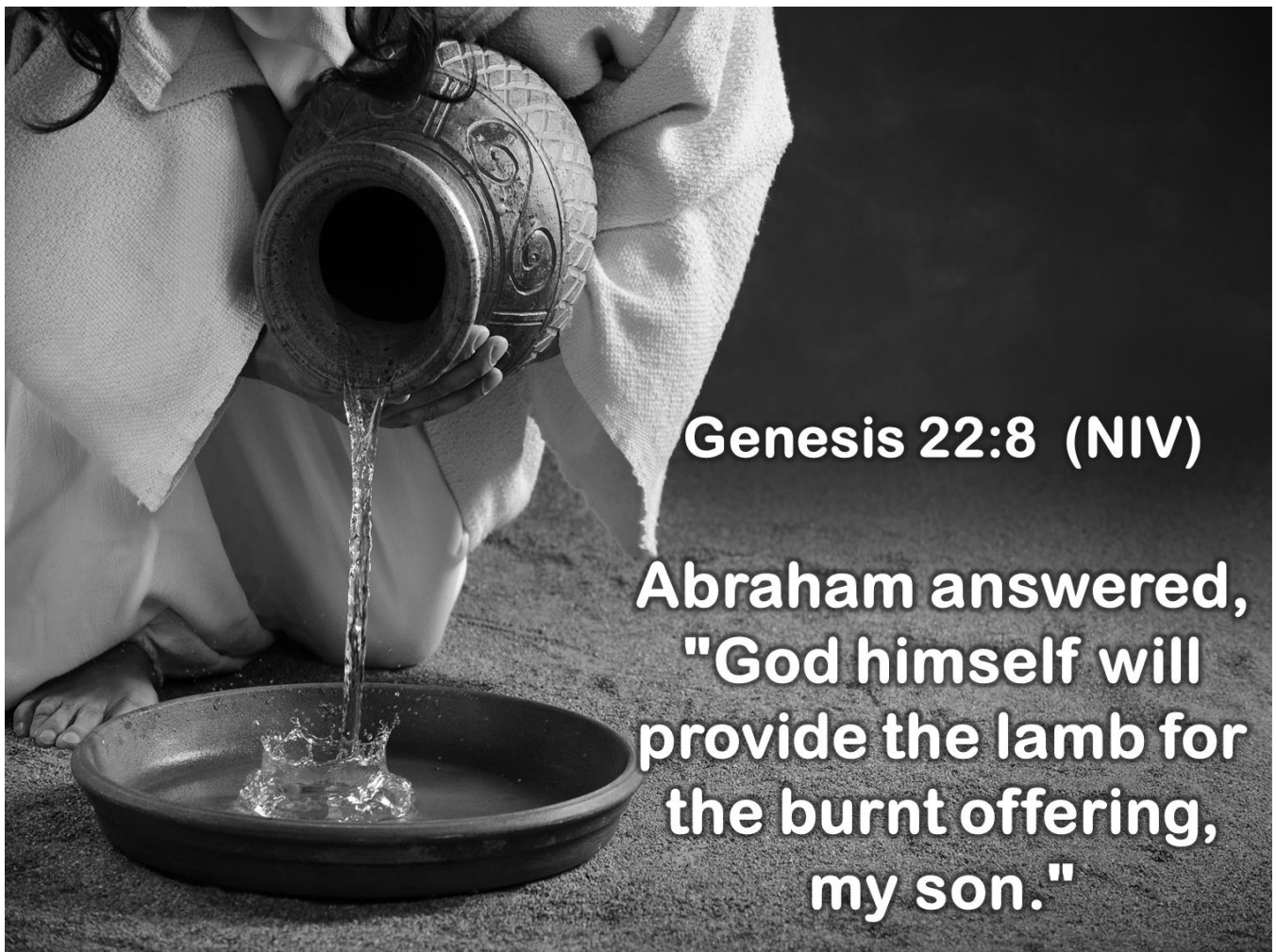

DAILY PRAYER GUIDE BASED ON THE SEVEN MOUNTAINS OF INFLUENCE

(Dick Eastman, 2012)

1. RELIGION (The Church and her ministries)

- Pray for 19 Sunday School teachers and helpers who are in Philippines from 13th March to 18th March, joining Pastor Bill Wilson for a mission trip to touch the poor children from the slum areas and cemeteries. They will participate in the sidewalk Sunday School there.
 - Pray for journey mercies, protection, good health and be a blessing to the children there and be blessed with new experiences.
- A) **Cell Group Ministry Conference 2018**
- Pray for CGMC 2018, upholding the CGMC 2018 Task Force, for unity among all the members working harmoniously as a team for the success of the Conference.
 - Pray for members of the church to be encouraged to sign up early and for members of other churches, especially in Ipoh to do so as well.
- B) **Pray for CGMC's Jubilee Year**
- ❖ **CGMC 50th Anniversary Coffee Table Book.**
 - Pray for the Committee as they work tirelessly on gathering resources, compilation, layout, design, printing and for everything to run smoothly until completion.
 - ❖ **CGMC Creative Arts Concert & Homecoming Worship on Friday, 13 April 2018 and CGMC 50th Anniversary Combined Celebration on Sunday, 29 April 2018.**
 - Pray for the preparation towards the events that there will be good response and enthusiastic participants among three congregations and that God's faithfulness be shown and magnified.

2. FAMILY AND MARRIAGES (Youth, Children, Marriage, etc)

- A) A couple was each sentenced to 15 months jail and fined RM28,000 by the Session Court in Ipoh recently for exploiting 19 children into becoming beggars.
- Pray for the protection of children in our country from physical and sexual abuses and other forms of exploitation.
- B) Pray for the wellbeing and health of thousands of children caught in armed conflicts and are staying in refugee camps throughout the Middle East. Pray for various International Aid organizations to continue providing essential food and medicine for their basic needs and education.

3. GOVERNMENT (State, National and International)

- A) **Pray for the coming 14th General Elections.**
- Pray for the Election Commission, the Police and all political parties to play their roles to ensure the elections are carried out fairly, orderly and transparently.
 - Pray for wisdom and discernment in all eligible voters to come out to vote without fear or favour.
 - Pray for the Lord's choice of candidates to be elected for a stable government to be formed and a strong opposition to provide check and balance for sound administration.

Mission Prayer Items (March 2018)

Many things in the mission field can ONLY be achieved through prayers. We covet your prayers as the mission team continues to plough on in the fields where the harvests are plentiful but workers are few.

1) Nepalese OutReach

Tasek Nepali Community Center was set up end of December last year for the sole purpose of reaching out to the Nepalese community that is working and residing within the Tasek area. A weekly service is being held every Sunday evening since January 2018.

There is on average about 20-30 Nepalese attending each service. God's presence is evident in these services as we continue to see many being healed of sicknesses and lives surrendered to Jesus Christ.

Prayer Items :

- Pray for the hearts of Nepali brothers and sisters to continue to be moved to want to know Jesus more.
- Pray that we will be able to find a FULL TIME Nepali Pastor.
- Pray for more willing hearts and hands to serve and be a part of this ministry.

2) Orang Asli English Education

One of the challenge with the orang asli children is high drop out rate when they move into secondary school. We recently sent 2 orang asli girls (14 & 15yrs old) to Promise Home in Kota Kemuning in the hope that they will be better equipped to continue with their secondary school education. Promise Home is a christian hostel in Kota Kemuning run by Ps Iris & team with the aim of providing the OA children opportunity to excel in school by offering free lodging , free tuition and a stable home environment.

Prayer Items :

- Prayer of thanksgiving to God for opening doors for us in this area.
- Pray that the 2 girls will be able to assimilate well into their new environment and that they will live up to the purpose that God has in their live.

3) Mission Trip To Nabawan, Sabah

Mission Trip to Nabawan, Sabah has been set for Mar 25th – Mar 28th. This is an exploratory trip organised by TRAC Perak District to look into mission work opportunities especially in the area of Pre-school (partnering with SIB). 4 members from CGMC (Lily Loh, Ong Lee Li, Dr Gill & Peterson) will be participating in this mission trip.

Prayer Items:

- Pray for safe journey, good weather and good health as the team prepares for this trip.
- Pray for unity of hearts as the team comes together from different background.
- Pray for God's hand of protection and guidance upon this team.

Lesson on God's Testing

-----questions for sermon discussion-----


1. What are some observations you make from the passage about God testing the faith of Abraham? Why does God want to test Abraham?
Were you ever put in any situation where your faith was tested? What did you learn? Are you going through a testing now? Share it.
2. What are the evidences that Abraham obeyed God? What does Abraham expect the outcome of this testing? (See also Heb. 11:17-19.) How do you think Abraham's faith might have "grown" after the test?
How did your faith "grow" after the test?
3. God provides (Yahweh Yireh) for Abraham a ram. What are some promises of God's provision for us in our Christian journey?
What are some testimonies you can share to encourage others about God's provision for you?
4. Read vv 16-18. How does our covenant with God depend on our response to Him? How do we know that we are responding to God? How would we know if we are not responding to God?
5. Do you agree that the Christian life is more like a Roller Coaster than an LRT experience? Does having a smooth secure life (like LRT) indicate that everything is ok? Does having an up and down life (Roller Coaster) indicate that we are not ok? Explain the normal Christian life. When you are going through a roller coaster, how does your faith in God help?
