2. RELIGION (The Church and her ministries)

A) Cell Group Ministry Conference 2018

1) Nepali Out-Reach

CGMC Nepali ministry is set up to share God's word and win lives for Christ among the Nepali workers in Ipoh.

A weekly service is held every Sunday evening for this purpose in Tasek Nepali Community Center (TNCC) since January 2018. This ministry is in need of Nepali speaking ministry workers to minister effectively to the Nepali.

Prayer Items :

We thank God for sis Samjhana (Korean missionary in Nepal for 17 years) who has agreed to help in TNCC while she is here in Malaysia.

- Pray that many Nepali will be touched and their faith build up through bible study (by sis Samjhana).
- Pray for boldness to move forward to embrace the expansion of the Nepali ministry as God leads.

2) Ulu Kinta Community Center (UKCC)

UKCC held its 1st Easter celebration on April 8th. The celebration started with dinner, followed by worship, sermon by Ps Andrew Tan (bro Leonard Lim as translator), Sunday School song presentation and closing prayer by Ps Richard Leow.

Prayer Items :

- Pray that more people, families and children from the Ulu Kinta community will be drawn to UKCC to hear the word of God and to be ministered to.
- Pray for more Bahasa Malaysia speaking people to come forth to serve as Sunday school teachers and drivers.

3) Liberton Kirk Church Scotland

Liberton Kirk Church in Scotland is a church CGMC Mission partner with to encourage each other in mission outreach through sharing and prayers. They too celebrated their 50th anniversary on May 1st with a Malaysian lunch on the same day.

Prayer Items:

- Pray that as Liberton Kirk has completed their planning for their summer programme, God will continue to guide 'them in executing the plans and bless their labor.
- Pray for the on-going planning for their Alpha Program which will be their major autumn outreach activities.

SERMON OUTLINE

19 May 2018 (Saturday)

MATTHEW 4:23-25, 1 CORINTHIANS 3:6, 9:22-23, 2 CORINTHIANS 10: 3-5 TODAY'S PRE- EVANGELISM MINISTRY

- I. The rationale [1 Cor. 3:6]
 1. Its needs
 - a. The world shows no interest towards gospel
 - b. The world is changing.
 2. Its definition
'Evangelism is every day and in every way helping your non believing friends to take one step closer to JC.'
- II. The process evangelism
 1. In the kingdom of God aspect [Mt 4:23-25]
 - a. Jesus' example
The coming of the Kingdom of God is the core objective and value of the gospel.
 - b. Our evangelism content includes:
Jesus came as Messianic king.
Man failed.
Redemption through Christ's atonement and the renewal of Holy Spirit.
Proclaim the kingship and Lordship of Jesus.
Profess the affirmation of Christian faith.
Show filial to Christ's kingship.
Witness through communal works and services
Become his nation and people.
 2. In communal church aspect [Mk 1:15]
 - a. Evangelism in the communal aspect would be:
 - i. The reign of God and the collectiveness of discipleship and doing the will of God.
 - ii. The community faith of church becomes the core of the gospel.
 - iii. The church mission is submission to His Messianic kingship.
 - iv. The great commission becomes prominence in Christian life and living.
 - b. Three priorities in evangelism today:
Belonging comes before believing.
Discipleship comes before decision.
Co-operation comes before conversation.
 3. In Conversational aspect [2 Cor 4:4, 1 Cor 9:22-23, 2 Cor 10:3-5]
 - a. Hearing conversations
 - b. Illuminating conversations
 - c. Uncovering conversations
 - d. Building conversations

Conclusion:

Pre evangelism or process evangelism is necessary in today's evangelism. It creates and opens more opportunity to reach out to people. Evangelism must be done through the communal church. Probing the right questions will draw the un-churched people a step nearer to Christ.

2. Recall a time when you had conversation with your friend, and asked some questions, and helped him /her to drawn closer to Christ. Share why the questions that you asked is helpful to them?


