DAILY PRAYER GUIDE BASED ON THE SEVEN MOUNTAINS OF INFLUENCE (Dick Eastman, 2012)

You are encouraged to use the following in your daily intercession.

As you are led by the Holy Spirit, pray specifically for our church, other churches, our nation and nations of the world.

1 RELIGION (The Church and her ministries)

- Pray for the Holy Spirit's anointing on all churches regardless of their denominations.
- Pray for ministries involved in evangelism and discipleship including foreign missionary activity.

Thank God for the close cooperation between the staff and members of the Management Committee which ensured that the shifting of all the machines and equipment to the new centre was completed in one day on 15th Oct and the new centre could begin fully functioning the next day.

- Thank God for the smooth and successful transition from the old centre to the new centre. The new centre was fully operational immediately the day after the move. Praise the Lord!
- Pray for the Lord's blessing and protection on the new Haemodialysis Centre, for the staff to be able to work in harmony and peace and for the patients to receive good treatment.
- Pray for the various cell group members to reach out to the patients with the love of God in 'Be a Blessing!' anniversary emphasis.

Pray for CGMC's Jubilee Year

- As we celebrate the Jubilee Year, pray for unity among the pastors, leaders and members and for the Lord's favour to bring about a mighty spiritual breakthrough in all our ministries.
- Pray for 'Be A Blessing' project, that all cell groups, leaders and members will enthusiastically take up a project or two to bless those who are in need with the love and grace of God, and in turn be blessed.

2 FAMILY AND MARRIAGES (Youth, Children, Marriage, etc)

- Pray for families in general, and particularly for the healing of broken relationships in marriages and families especially among believers and those in Christian ministry.

3 EDUCATION (All Schools, Universities, Colleges and Educators)

The focus is to pray for all institutions of learning; be they for the very young, as children are so easily influenced and for those catering for higher education.

- Pray for teachers and educators. Pray for those whom you know by name.

4 BUSINESS (The Marketplace)

This focus involves praying for a spiritual awakening in the marketplace.

- Pray especially that God will use Christian businessman and businesswomen to influence others in their professions.
- Pray that major corporations will build their companies on a foundation of high moral and ethical standards.

5 GOVERNMENT (State, National and International)

Pray for the leaders of our state and the national government. Remember especially to intercede for the judiciary (judges) of our nation and the nations of the world. Intercede also for the military, the police and civil servants.

- Pray that Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Abdul Razak, as the foremost person in the position of governing authority in our nation, will be Prime Minister of all the people in Malaysia, upholding the multiracial and multi-religious character of our country and be willing to speak out against any racial and religious bigotry.
- Pray also for all political leaders on both sides of the political divide to speak out against racial and religious extremism.

The Malay Rulers have expressed in a statement their concern that unity and harmony in the country is eroding following a series of racial and religious controversies. They affirmed that unity among Malaysia's multi-ethnic and multi-religious people is the key to ensuring the country's ongoing stability.

- Pray for the Malay rulers, for their collective wisdom and concern for the multi-racial and multi-religious people of this nation.
- Pray that the Malay rulers' expressed statement will spur our political leaders to act more responsibly to stamp out racial and religious extremism.

It has been more than 230 days since the abduction of Pastor Raymond Koh, and longer for three other persons who have also disappeared.

- Thank God for an activist group called CAGED which has pledged to continue holding vigil in Dataran Merdeka on the last Saturday of every month until the truth is known.

CAGED stands for Citizen Action Group in Enforced Disappearance. As defined by the UN, enforced disappearance occurs when a person is secretly abducted or imprisoned by a state or political organisation or by a third party with the authorisation support or acquiescence of a state or political organization.

- Besides the effort carried out by CAGED, we thank God that SUHAKAM, the Malaysian Human Rights Commission will be holding a public inquiry into the missing persons including Pastor Raymond Koh, beginning in October.

Suhakam will be holding a Public Inquiry on the 19th, 20th and 30th October and 2nd November.

- Pray for wisdom for the remaining witness to answer the difficult questions and to tell the truth and for the truth behind the disappearances to be made known.

6 MEDIA (The Press, Television, Internet, Social Network)

- Ask God to cause all aspects of the media and information technology to become a tool in His hands to change the culture around us for His honour and glory.

7 ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT (including sports)

This focus includes all the various fields of the arts and entertainment including sports. Ask God to use Christians in these areas to influence and impact those around them.
