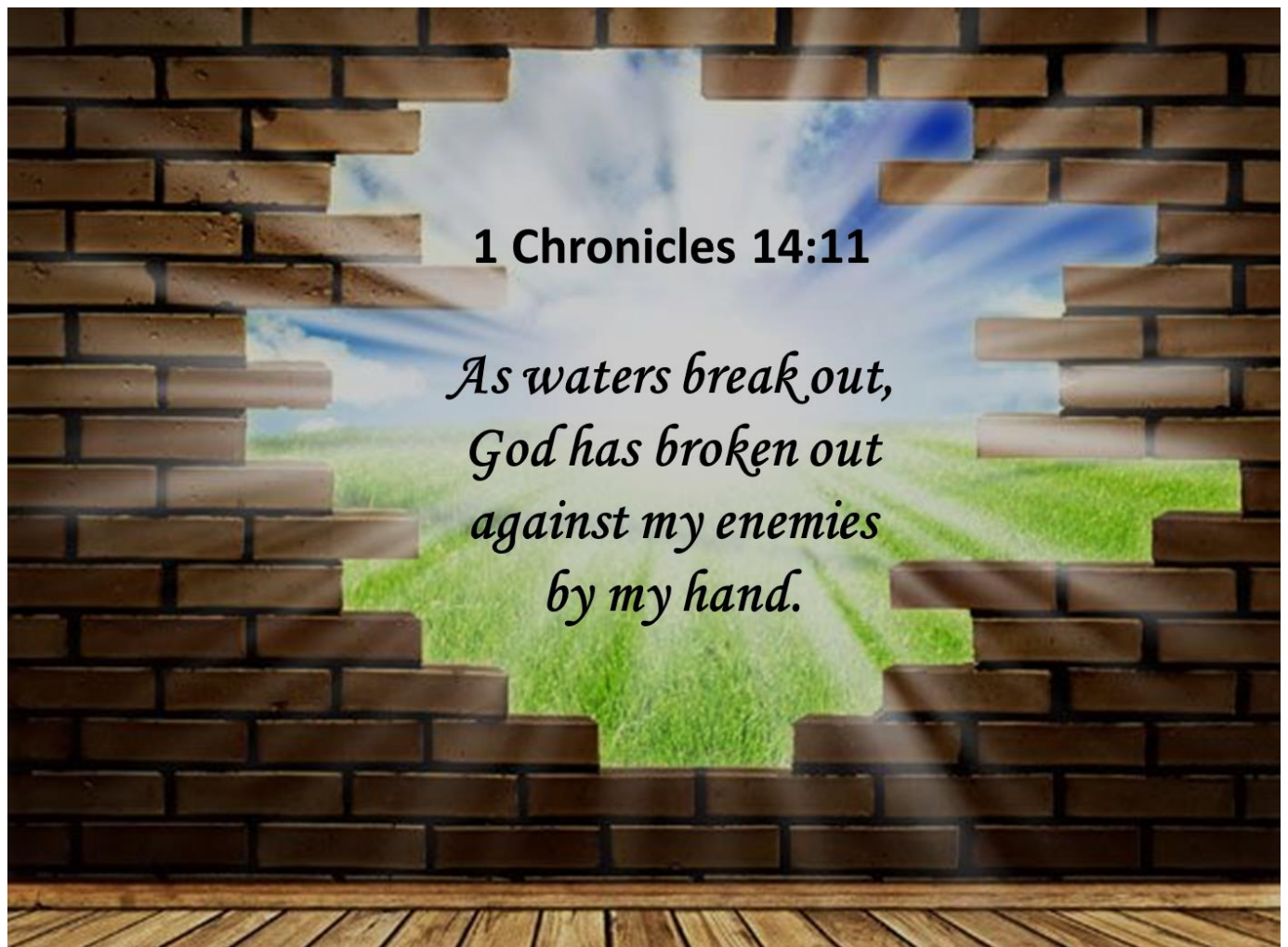

# DAILY PRAYER GUIDE BASED ON THE SEVEN MOUNTAINS OF INFLUENCE (Dick Eastman, 2012)

You are encouraged to use the following in your daily intercession. As you are led by the Holy Spirit, pray specifically for our church, other churches, our nation and nations of the world.

## 1 RELIGION (The Church and her ministries)

- Pray for the Holy Spirit's anointing on all churches regardless of their denominations.
- Pray for ministries involved in evangelism and discipleship including foreign missionary activity.

Pray for CGMC's Jubilee Year

- As we celebrate the Jubilee Year, pray for unity among the pastors, leaders and members for the Lord's favour to bring about a mighty spiritual breakthrough in all our ministries.
- Pray for our past CGMC pastors who will be coming to preach, that the Lord will speak to each one of them, so that the word and message will be encouraging and prophetic.
- Pray for 'Be A Blessing' project, that all cell groups, leaders and members will enthusiastically take up a project or two to bless those who are in need with the love and grace of God, and in turn be blessed.

## 2 FAMILY AND MARRIAGES (Youth, Children, Marriage, etc)

- Pray for families in general, and particularly for the healing of broken relationships in marriages and families especially among believers and those in Christian ministry.

## 3 EDUCATION (All Schools, Universities, Colleges and Educators)

The focus is to pray for all institutions of learning; be they for the very young, as children are so easily influenced, or for those catering for higher education.

- Pray for teachers and educators. Pray for those whom you know by name.

## 4 BUSINESS (The Marketplace)

This focus involves praying for a spiritual awakening in the marketplace.

- Pray especially that God will use Christian businessman and businesswomen to influence others in their professions.
- Pray that major corporations will build their companies on a foundation of high moral and ethical standards.

## 5 GOVERNMENT (State, National and International)

Pray for the leaders of our state and the national government. Remember especially to intercede for the judiciary (judges) of our nation and the nations of the world. Intercede also for the military, the police and civil servants.

- Pray for the new Inspector-General of Police, Datuk Seri Mohamad Fuzi Harun, for strong resolve and conviction to act without fear or favour in order to regain public confidence in the police force.
- Pray that he will act to clean up the force of corrupt practices and seek to get rid of 'bad apples' in the police force.

- Pray for the coming 14<sup>th</sup> General Election to be peaceful and free of violence.
- Pray for Malaysians of integrity and character who uphold the Federal Constitution as the supreme law of the country and multiculturalism to offer themselves as candidates for the State and Parliamentary constituencies and for God's choice to be elected into office.

According to the Election Commission there are currently 14.6 million registered voters and 3.7 million eligible to vote but yet to register.

- Pray that all registered voters will come out to vote and more eligible voters will register so that they can vote during the coming General Election.

It has been more than 200 days since the abduction of Pastor Raymond Koh, and longer for three other persons who have also disappeared.

- Thank God for an activist group called CAGED which has pledged to continue holding vigil in Dataran Merdeka on the last Saturday of every month until the truth is known.

CAGED stands for Citizen Action Group in Enforced Disappearance. As defined by UN, enforced disappearance occurs when a person is secretly abducted or imprisoned by a state or political organisation or by a third party with the authorisation support or acquiescence of a state or political organization.

- Besides the effort carried out by CAGED, we thank God that SUHAKAM, the Malaysian Human Rights Commission will be holding a public inquiry into the missing persons including Pastor Raymond Koh, beginning in October.
- Pray for wisdom and protection on the members of SUHAKAM to find the truth behind the disappearance of the missing persons.
- Pray for peace and strength for the families of Pastor Raymond and the other persons who have disappeared.

## **6 MEDIA (The Press, Television, Internet, Social Network)**

- Ask God to cause all aspects of the media and information technology to become a tool in His hands to change the culture around us for His honour and glory.

## **7 ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT (including sports)**

This focus includes all the various fields of the arts and entertainment including sports. Ask God to use Christians in these areas to influence and impact those around them.

## SERMON NOTES

### PERSONAL BREAKTHROUGH

SCRIPTURE: 1 CHRONICLES 14:8-12; PHILIPPIANS 4:6-9

SPEAKER: PS. TAN MOY HOW

#### A. Introduction

Baal Perazim means, *“the Lord, who breaks out.”*

It is the Lord who gave the breakthrough!

What is your GIANT to overcome?

#### The Big Idea:

**“To see a personal breakthrough, inquire of Him first.”**

#### B. How Do We Get A Personal Breakthrough?

1. Do not be anxious about anything (Philippians 4:6<sup>a</sup>)

Switch focus by fasting and prayer.

- (Daniel 9:3) *So I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with Him in prayer and petition, in fasting, and in sackcloth and ashes.*
- (Ezra 8:23) *So we fasted and petitioned our God about this, and He answered our prayer.*

2. Pray about everything

(Philippians 4:6<sup>b</sup>) *“... but in everything, by prayer and petition...”*

- (1 Peter 5:7) *“Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.”*
- (Luke 18:1-8) The Parable of the Persistent Widow

### 3. Present your requests anytime

(Philippians 4:6<sup>c</sup>) “...with thanksgiving, present your requests (anytime) to God...”

- (Matthew 11:28) “Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.”
- (John 16:24) “Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.”

### C. The Result

(Philippians 4:7) “And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

(Philippians 4:9) “Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me — put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.
