



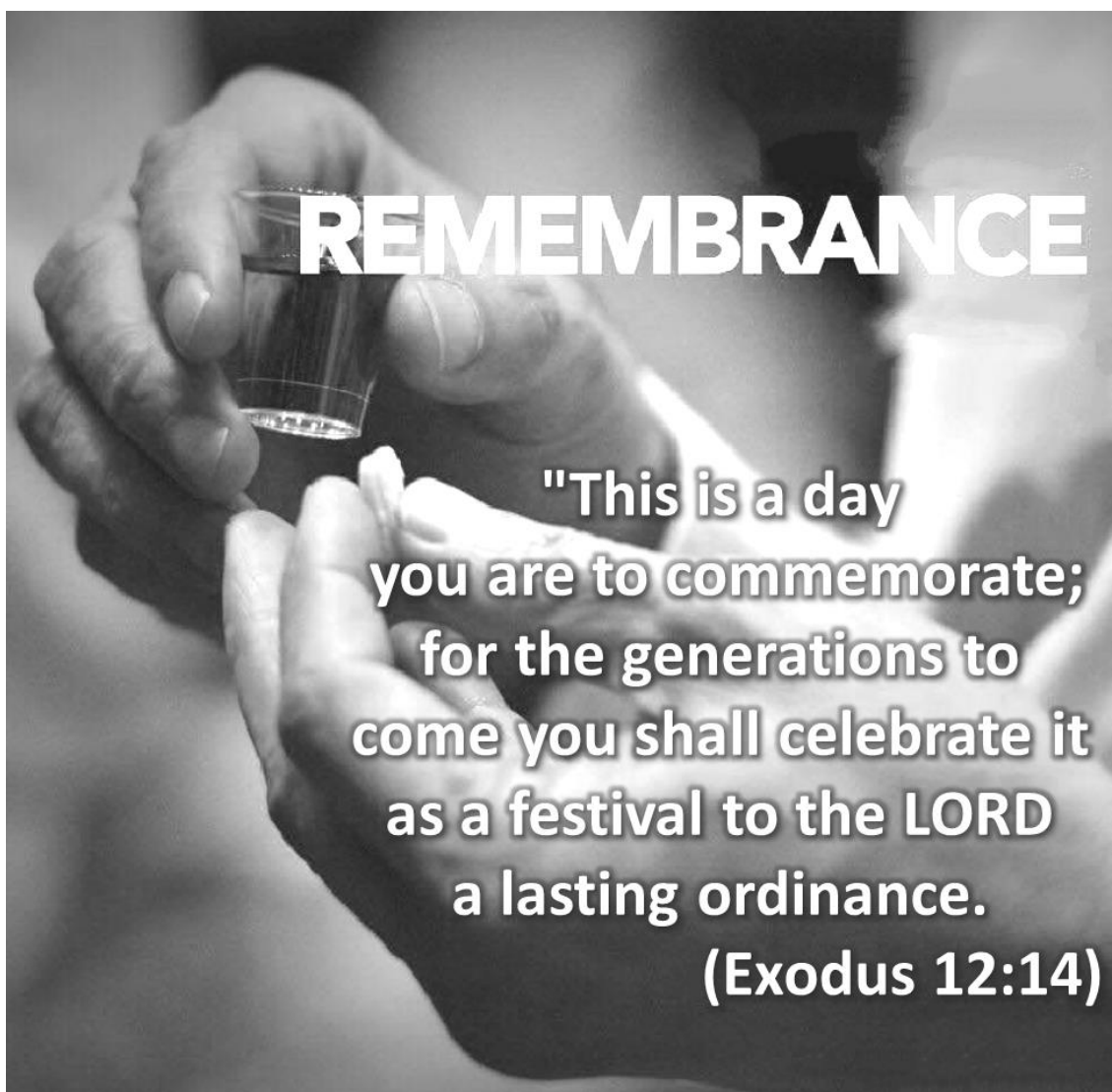

SERMON OUTLINE

THE FINAL JUDGMENT

EXODUS 11:1-10; 12:29-42; 13:1-2, 11-16

Introduction

1. The Plague of Death on Egyptian Firstborns 11:1-10

'About midnight I will go throughout Egypt. 5 Every firstborn son in Egypt will die, from the firstborn son of Pharaoh, who sits on the throne, to the firstborn son of the slave girl, who is at her hand mill, and all the firstborn of the cattle as well. 6 There will be loud wailing throughout Egypt.' (vv 4-6)

Lessons

- a) God warns before He judges.
- b) We must repent before it is too late.
- c) We must preach the gospel.

2. The Hasty Departure from Egypt 12:29-42

During the night Pharaoh summoned Moses and Aaron and said, "Up! Leave my people, you and the Israelites! Go, worship the LORD as you have requested. Take your flocks and herds, as you have said, and go. (vv 31-32)

Lessons:

- a) The story of Exodus is rooted in history.
- b) Our Christian faith is rooted in history.

3. The Consecration of Israel's Firstborns 13:1-2, 11-16

"Consecrate to me every firstborn male. The first offspring of every womb among the Israelites belongs to me, whether man or animal." (v 2)

Lessons

- a) Jesus paid the price of redemption for us.
- b) We belong to God, not to ourselves.
- c) Our children belong to God.

-----questions for sermon discussion-----

1. How is the story and message of Exodus repeated in our day? In view of God's coming judgment (2nd Coming) what must we do?
2. Why is it important that we insist that our Christian faith is grounded in history? What issues are at stake?
3. How does the story of redemption in Exodus teach the Israelites about consecrating their firstborns (children)? How is this applied to us in the NT?
